Christian young people should dress in a way consistent with Biblical principles of decency. In 1Timothy 2:9 and 1 Peter 3:3, we are asked to refrain from extremes which call attention to ourselves. The matter of dress is directly related to the kind of people we are and what we think ourselves to be.

Children will stay in the school uniform until a parent or guardian, or bus picks up the student unless the child is attending the Guardian Angels Program. (Please see the Guardian Angel Handbook.)

Any student who violates these guidelines will or may be asked to return home to change. Persistent violators will meet with the teacher, principal, and their parents.

Dress Code Guidelines

This is what the students are required to wear...if it is **NOT** listed here, they **SHOULD NOT** wear it.

Students are required to wear the proper St. James Catholic School uniform at all times unless parents are notified otherwise. Parker School Uniforms is the basic supplier of our uniforms. Uniforms must be clean and in good condition at all times!

<u>Highly Prefer Parker Clothing – Yes, we are aware that the clothing Parker sells is more expensive. However, we believe</u> that the Parker clothing doesn't fade as much, lasts longer, wears well, and is a higher quality.

Boys & Girls:

Belt: Solid Black, Navy Blue, or Brown colored belt.

Shoes: Closed Toe Dress shoes-black, brown, navy, or white, *non-marking soles*, no heel higher than one

inch. Shoes **should** have a back or solid non-marking athletic shoes with shoelaces-white, black or gray. Gym shoes (non-marking) are required for P.E. If not wearing gym shoes, student will

sit out of class for that day. No sparkle or lighted shoes.

Pants: Navy Blue (must be worn with belt).

Shorts: Navy Blue: August, first two weeks in September and all of May. Length - No shorter than two

inches above the middle of the knee and no longer than the bottom of the knee.

Jackets/Sweaters: Parker brand (V-neck or Cardigan).

Sweatshirt: St. James Uniform or Spirit Day Sweatshirt or Parker Style (Cardigan or V-neck)

Watches: Watches may be worn.

Boys:

Shirts: Blue Plaid or White Short-Sleeve Polo Knit. T-shirts/undershirts worn under uniform shirts must

be white and t-shirt sleeves must not be seen sticking out from below the uniform shirt.

Socks: Mostly Solid White socks. Crew socks preferred...must cover the ankle bone.

Vest: Parker Style only.

<u>Girls</u>:

Shirts: White Short-Sleeve Polo Knit or White Turtle Neck.

Socks: Mostly Solid White socks. Crew/Bobby socks preferred...must cover the ankle bone.

Tights: White or Navy Blue.

Leggings: Solid White or Navy Blue Full-length Leggings. Socks must cover bottom of leggings at all

times when worn.

Jumpers: <u>K-5th grades (only):</u> V-Front Fitted Waist Jumper (Stock Number: 687) Knee Length or longer.

Skirts: <u>Sixth grade (only):</u> Pleated Skirt Knee-length or longer.

Hair Accessories: Parker Plaid, black, blue, or white item.

Earrings: Girls may wear post/stud earrings only (only one piercing per ear on bottom ear lobe).

No Make-Up, Cologne, Perfume, Hats, Jewelry, Nail Polish, or Nail Extenders.

Prescription Glasses: Students that wear RX glasses must wear them during the school day.

Hair: Boys' hair should not touch the collar or top the ears. No colored/dyed/faddish cuts.

No feathers or extensions.

NO UNIFORM TODAY: "NUT Day" will be on the second Tuesday of the month. Occasionally a "NUT Day" may be authorized by the principal. Parents will be notified in advance of these special dress days.

On "NUT Day" students may wear full-length plain blue denim jeans (in good condition) and their St. James T-shirt, St. James Spirit Day or Uniform sweatshirt, or their uniform shirt.

Students need to wear a belt with their jeans.
